Enrollment:	24 students in preschool; 48 students in kindergarten, 377 students in grades 1-8	
Faculty:	19 classroom instructors, 7 specialty teachers, full-time counselor, and 6 classroom assistants. 64% have earned a Master's Degree.	
Media Center:	The library has over 10,000 volumes, a reference station, an automated circulation system, and 4 Accelerated Reader desktop computers. The two computer labs have, combined, 50 desktop computers. There are more than 150 computers school-wide. Each homeroom class has an overhead LCD projector and a SmartBoard. Educational software available in the labs and classrooms includes Earobics, STAR Reader, Accelerated Reader, STAR Literacy, MathFacts in a Flash, Microsoft Office, United Streaming, ReadAbout, and Smart Response. Two NEO2 portable computer labs, 3 Elmo document cameras and 3 Smart Response Systems are available for classroom instruction.	
Curriculum Highlights:	The curriculum at OLOL is a comprehensive academic program with special instruction in computers, art, physical education, music, media skills, phonics and Spanish.
