<b>ENROLLMENT:</b>	444 students Kindergarten-8 <sup>th</sup> Grade
<b>FACULTY:</b>	17 classroom instructors, 7 special area teachers, full time counselor, 4 classroom assistants and a Director of Religious Education. 81% of the faculty has a Master's Degree.
<b>MEDIA CENTER:</b>	Over 8,000 volumes, audio visual center, CD-ROM reference stations, automated circulation system, library skills instruction. Two computer labs. Front lab has 28 Dell PCs purchased in the summer of 2003. Back lab has 18 PCs for use with Earobics, Accelerated Reader, Star Diagnostic Test, word-processing and research. Twenty new Dell PC's purchased 2004-05 for classrooms.
<b>CURRICULUM HIGHLIGHTS:</b>	Comprehensive academic program with specialty area of instruction in computers, art, physical education, music, media center skills, Spanish.
<b>CO-CURRICULAR HIGHLIGHTS:</b>	Student Council, Governor's Cup, Young Authors, Spanish Club, Accelerated Reader, Art Club, City Spelling Bee, Book Bee, Safety Patrol, Big Brother/Big Sister interaction with K & 7 , 1& 8 grades, many community service projects, school-wide recycling program, unique school "Families" concept developed as student leadership program.
