



Sanctuary Attire

At the June Worship Committee meeting we started a discussion of Sanctuary Attire. We define sanctuary attire as the appropriate dress for those ministers who will enter the sanctuary during mass — sacristans, lectors, communion ministers, adult servers, cantors and cross bearers. We first defined appropriate dress as what you would wear if you were going to a fine restaurant then we realized that wouldn't work because dress could be extremely informal there. Then someone suggested that sanctuary attire was what you would wear to a wedding or funeral. The consensus there was that everyone had seen a wide variety of dress at weddings and that would never define sanctuary attire. The only solution we could come up with was to simply spell out what we wanted to see.

A basic overall rule is that your attire should reflect your respect and reverence for the ONE you are serving. Clean and modest dress indicates that you are aware of this, and that it is a special privilege to serve at the table of the Lord.

First of all (and this applies to all ministries) shorts are never appropriate. The same for jeans — regardless of how much you paid for them, who designed them or how great they fit.

The ideal for men is a shirt, tie and jacket. Either the tie or jacket can be omitted; but the shirt must have a collar.

For women a pants outfit, skirt and blouse/sweater or dress is appropriate. No mini-skirts, halter tops or low-cut blouses. If you select a pants outfit it should not be so casual that you appear to be going to a picnic immediately after mass without an opportunity to change.


Now for the remaining ministers: Choir, Hospitality, Gift Bearers, Super Greeters. The choir already follows these guidelines. The hospitality ministers are more in synch with this dress code during the winter than the summer but with the level of air conditioning in church, slipping into a jacket after you arrive is not too much of a hardship.

It is really refreshing to see a family of gift bearers who have taken this obligation seriously and appear with their younger children all dressed up for the occasion.

Super Greeters are at the doors in all kinds of weather so we can cut them some slack.

Some of the improper attire problems occur when someone is drafted to fill-in for a no show.

The communion captain and the sacristan should be selective in drafting replacements always keeping in mind adherence to the basic rules of sanctuary attire.


Now you're probably thinking that we ought to be grateful for your stewardship and shouldn't complain about what you're wearing. And we are grateful. But think how jarring it would be to receive the Body of Christ from a man in shorts and a tee-shirt. Or how distracting to have someone proclaim the word of God from the ambo in a halter top. We are striving to maintain a certain level of dignity and respect for our roles as liturgical ministers. This will enhance the worship experience for everyone.

Dedication of the Lateran Cathedral in Rome



Most Catholics think of St. Peter's as the pope's main church but they are wrong. St. John Lateran is the pope's church, the cathedral of the Diocese of Rome where the Bishop of Rome presides.

The first basilica on the site was built in the fourth century when Constantine

donated land he had received from the wealthy Lateran family. The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica has been celebrated by the entire church on November 9 since the twelfth century and marks the dedication of the church by Pope Sylvester I in 324. It was

originally named the Arch-basilica of the Most Holy Savior but it is called St. John Lateran from the family who donated the land and because the monks from the monastery of St. John the Baptist and St. John the Devine served it. That structure and its successors suffered fire, earthquake and the ravages of war, but the Lateran remained the church where popes were consecrated until the popes returned from Avignon in the 14th century to find the church and the adjoining palace in ruins.

Pope Innocent X commissioned the present structure in 1646. One of Rome's most imposing churches, the Lateran's towering facade is crowned with fifteen colossal statues of Christ, John the Baptist, John the Evangelist and twelve doctors of the Church. Beneath its high altar rest the remains of the small wooden table on which tradition holds St. Peter himself celebrated mass.

St. John Lateran is, in a sense, the parish church of all Catholics, for it is the pope's parish, the cathedral church of the Bishop of Rome. This church is the spiritual home of the people who are the Church.



Christ the King

Jesus Christ is king of all creation. At the end of Matthew's Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that all authority in heaven and on earth has been given to him (28:18). The Revelation of John calls him King of kings and Lord of lords (19:16). People wanted to make Jesus a king after he worked the miracle of the loaves, but he went away by himself instead (Jn 6:15). They wanted a secular king to govern their land. Jesus wanted to rule their hearts.


The Catholic Church celebrates the kingship of Christ on the last Sunday of the church year. The liturgical year reaches its climax in a celebration that honors the supreme command of Christ. He has dominion over all creation, and he rules every person who believes in him.

The feast of Christ the King entered the Catholic calendar in 1925, which Pope Pius XI had set aside as a holy year. Pius thought the feast would bring the year to a solemn close, help combat the forces of secularism, and remind the world that Christ is its ultimate ruler. The pope chose the last Sunday of October because of its proximity to the end of the liturgical year and to serve as



a prelude to All Saints Day on Nov. 1. The same day was already being observed as Reformation Sunday in the Protestant traditions.

Pope Paul VI moved the observance from the end of October to the very last Sunday of the church year in order to exalt its theme even more. Now we end the year with an idea that sums up all that we have celebrated and that prepares us to start anew: this Jesus, whose birth we will soon celebrate, is the king of all creation.

On behalf of the Worship Committee, I want to thank all the lectors for their parish stewardship. There are three new lectors for the 7:30AM mass for a total of 16. More 7:30 lectors would be welcomed. We also have new lectors at the 5:30, 9:30 and 11:30 masses. All are welcome!

Just a reminder- the lector should wait for a short period of time (3 to 5+ seconds) before approaching the ambo to read. This will allow the assembly time to absorb that portion of the mass before transitioning into the reading. At the end of the scripture reading,

stay standing close to the ambo, pause for 3-5+ seconds, say The Word of the Lord, then return to the pew.

This Leitourgia has an insert emphasizing reverencing the tabernacle and the ambo. The altar is revered with a profound bow if the lector will cross in front of the altar before and after reading the word. The lector never reverences the altar when approaching the ambo from the music side of church. The lector never reverences the ambo.
